Classroom Grant	Amount	Description
Piano Anywhere! <i>Fulton High School</i> Laurey Railton	\$1000	Students in the Piano Lab course learn basic skills of playing piano. This grant will provide portable roll-up keyboards for students to check out to take home. It will allow students without at home pianos to continue building their skills through additional practice.
Using PCR and Electrophoresis Gel for Classroom Instruction in Biology and Genetics <i>Fulton High School</i> Liz Schwab and Casie Farmer	\$1000	Students in three FHS science classes learn about the biology of all living things. This project purchases equipment to expand genetic typing units in Biology and Genetics classes.
Active Learning with Future Innovators Continuation Grant (2 nd Year) <i>Fulton Early Childhood Center</i> Shannon Forbis	\$1000	This project will provide student materials needed to fully implement the HighScope Curriculum providing high quality hands-on learning experiences in a small group setting. Funds will replenish supplies for a gardening project and purchase new materials to expand student learning.
Learning with LEGOS <i>Bartley School</i> Nikki Long and Sharon Wright	\$500	This project provides an educational LEGO set, including lessons and activities, to promote 4 th grade students' fundamental STEM understanding of simple and powered machines, structures and mechanisms.
Ready for Kindergarten <i>Fulton Early Childhood Center</i> Jen Meyerhoff, Director of the FECC	\$500	The Fulton Early Childhood Center facility/staff will obtain materials, supplies, and resources to help prepare Pre-K students for their upcoming kindergarten experience. This project will focus on the social and emotional development of Pre-K students.
Empty Bowl Fundraiser <i>Fulton High School</i> Bee Brooks and Megan Davis	\$1000	Students will create food-safe ceramic bowls in their FHS art classes. During the FHS Fine Arts Night, attendees may contribute \$10 for soup in their choice of these bowls. They may keep the bowl and the proceeds of the fundraiser will go to the local food bank.
Bush Bus Buddies <i>Bush School</i> Whitney Eastwood, Debra Hunter and Kylie Lane	\$500	Kindergarten students will take field trips throughout the school year in the local community or surrounding communities. The field trips will vary from learning experiences to service learning projects that focus on giving back to others.
Kinder Space <i>Bush School</i> Whitney Eastwood, Debra Hunter and Kylie Lane	\$1000	This project will provide a Makerspace area in each kindergarten classroom. The area will incorporate engineering and crafting materials, STEM tasks, technology, robotics, and more. The hands-on experiences will be used for whole group, small group, and individual exploration.
I-Pads in the Classroom Continuation Grant (2nd Year) <i>McIntire School</i> Alison White, Michelle Moore	\$1000	Students will have the opportunity to bring more creativity across the curriculum, along with helping the teacher formatively assess their learning. Students will be able to integrate, problem solve, and use collaboration skills more effectively. 2 additional

		classroom I-pads/cases to be purchased.
Ed and Jean Avra Classroom History Grant: Exploring World War I <i>Fulton High School</i> Rose Bethell	\$500	This cross-curricular experience will impact 65 sophomore students who are enrolled in World History Honors and English II Honors. Students will visit the World War I Museum and Memorial in Kansas City, MO. This field experience will help students better understand the impact of WWI on the course of history. Students will have the opportunity to interact with over 300,000 objects and documents promoting students' personal connections to history.
